<p>GEN 102 - BIBLE STUDY METHODS Prof. Roberto Washington</p> <p>This course is to introduce the inductive Bible Study Method using three basic techniques: Observation, Interpretation, and Application. Emphasis will be on rightly dividing the Word of God.</p>	<p>BIB 100 – OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY Prof. Beatrice Guillory</p> <p>A survey of the Old Testament Laws surmises its purpose and application of the Israelites' moral, ceremonial, and civil laws and the relationship to Christianity in today's society.</p>	<p>THE 301 – RAPTURE ALERT I Prof. Louise Prince</p> <p>A study of the overall plan of God involves a detailed analysis of biblical prophecies as outlined in the old and new testaments concerning end-time events and last things. A study of those prophecies that have been fulfilled, which are presently being fulfilled, and those which will be in the imminent future as God brings about the culmination of His plan. The study of future events includes the Rapture, tribulation, second coming in its stages, the millennial reign of Christ, white throne judgment, and Eternal State. An analysis of recent current events and their fulfillment of end-time prophecies will be charted.</p>
<p>BIB 102 - NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY Prof. Eric Gibson</p> <p>An analysis of the New Testament books will be discussed, surmising its purpose, theme, author, and date written. Special attention is given to the synoptic gospels.</p>	<p>NEW</p> <p>MIN 201 – ALTAR WORKER MINISTRY/DEMONOLOGY Dr. Priscilla Brown & Dr. Rosetta Holmes</p> <p>This course is designed to develop and enhance the skills of altar workers as well as impart knowledge of spiritual warfare. The class will cover protocols, suggested procedures, strategies, hindrances, adversity, motives, and discernment relating to handling diverse situations in the church and the virtual media setting. Special attention will be given to subjects such as demonic forces and their power, warfare in the spiritual realm, their influences, and their increasing presence today, especially during ministry.</p>	<p>THE 201 – PRINCIPLES OF THE APOSTOLIC DOCTRINE Prof. Beverly Howard</p> <p>This course gives special attention to the foundational tenets of the Apostolic Faith. It is an essential course for those wishing to understand and articulate the beliefs and concerns of this particular church movement.</p>
<p>HIS 100 – HISTORY OF PENTECOST Prof. Allen Mitchell</p> <p>A short historical review from the Apostolic Age to the Modern Era is investigated. Also, the History of Pentecostal organization and the lives of Pentecostal stalwarts are examined.</p> <p>Zoom ID: Shared</p>	<p>NEW</p> <p>CED 300 – LEADERSHIP Dr. Herbert Parker</p> <p>6- Week Certificate Course</p> <p>This course will address leadership and the issues relative to the effective operation of the ministry. It provides instructions for the servant-leader role with appropriate situational approaches and responses.</p>	<p>ENG 300 – WRITING PREPARATION Prof. Martin Prince</p> <p>This course is designed to help students develop good writing skills. Emphasis is placed on the study of mechanics, sentence structure, and paragraph development in writing an essay. Fundamentals of English grammar are covered, and a brief introduction to preparing a research paper is given.</p>
