NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY (BIB 102)

Professor Eric Gibson

An analysis of the New Testament will be discussed, surmising its purpose, theme, author and date written. Special attention is given to the synoptic gospels.

BIBLE STUDY METHODS (GEN 102)

Professor Roberto Washington

This course is to introduce the inductive Bible Study Method using three basic techniques: Observation, Interpretation and Application. Emphasis will be on rightly dividing the Word of God.

HEALING FOR DAMAGED EMOTIONS (PSY 501)

Dr. Pamela Heller

This course explores emotional trauma or insecurities that are caused by an experience or event such as chronic abuse, bullying, discrimination or humiliation, guilt, anger, sadness, depression, etc. The student will study the impact of emotions and recognize when personal counseling and guidance are required.

6-Week Certificate Course

This forum allows men of all ages to focus on real-life situations. Men will strengthen and encourage one another while discussing biblical truths for today's culture.

OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY (BIB 100)

Evangelist Beatrice Guillory

A survey of the Old Testament Laws surmises its purpose and application of the Israelites' moral, ceremonial, and civil laws and the relationship to Christianity in today's society.

MONOTHEISM (THE 603)

Professor Barry Cox

This is a study of monotheism (one God), historical origin, and uniqueness. This course looks at the most influential attempts to establish God's uniqueness and characteristics of His omnipotent, omniscient, and omnipresent goodness.

HISTORY OF PENTECOST (HIS 100)

Professor Donald Barber

A short history is given of the Pentecostal movement from the Apostolic to the modern era. The history of Pentecostal organizations and the lives of Pentecostal stalwarts are reviewed.

UNDERSTANDING PEOPLE (CED 104)

Dr. Pricilla Brown

An overview of the physical, psychological and spiritual development of men and women from birth through childhood, adolescence, young adulthood, and maturity to the end of life. The focus of this course is upon the maturation processes, crises and vital choices inherent in each growth level with special emphasis on the effects on society and culture (majority/ minority) upon human development.

PERSONAL EVANGELISM (MIS 202)

Professor Eric Gibson

This course examines methods of effective witnessing, it provides students with practical experience in recognizing evangelistic opportunities and determining appropriate approaches.

BIBLICAL GREEK (LAN 301)

(Prerequisite Old & New Testament)

Dr. Herbert Parker

The student will learn to apply the principles of Greek syntax to various Greek texts. Students are provided with the tools needed to analyze the syntax of the Greek New Testament. The course delves into the translation of biblical verses and applying the principles of syntax to the verses.

UNDERSTANDING TEACHING (CED 100)

Professor Louise Prince

This is a comprehensive study of the characteristics of each age level in human development. A study is made of appropriate principles of teaching. To develop skilled leaders for Christian Education, family life, youth ministries and children's ministries. Consideration is also given to the role of Christian Education in evangelism.

PRINCIPLES OF THE APOSTOLIC DOCTRINE (APOSTOLICITY) (THE 201)

Professor Beverly Howard

This course gives special attention to the foundational tenets of the Apostolic Faith. It is an important course for those wishing to understand and articulate the beliefs and concerns of the particular church movement.

HERMENEUTICS (THE 204)

Professor Duane Odom

This course helps the student develop the ability, through study, to gain a proper understanding of Scripture. Various principles are treated as tools for biblical understanding. Biblical characteristics are examined which enhances scriptural clarity.

WRITING PREPARATION (ENG 300)

Professor Martin Prince

This course is designed to help students develop good writing skills. Emphasis is placed on the study of mechanics, sentence structure, and paragraph development in writing an essay. Fundamentals of English grammar are covered, and a brief introduction to preparing a research paper is given.

SPIRITUAL GROWTH & MATURITY (CED 202)

Dr. Mary Jordan

This course teaches self-examination fundamentals to growth, development and maturity of the Christian life. It addresses communication and relationship with God and one's fellow man. The main focus will be directed toward brokenness.

FIRESIDE CHAT

Six-week Certificated Course
